



Calculating the Cost of Inequality at GE

GE's two-tier wage cuts are more than just unfair. They have a severe impact on workers, their families and their communities. Here's the straight time cost to workers:

- Cut from \$30/hr to \$20/hr \$21,000/year
- Cut from \$30/hr to \$15/hr \$32,000/year

And here's how the new low pay for second-tier workers compares to pay for GE CEO Jeff Immelt, who recently got a pay increase:

- Low tier Grove City worker is paid \$32,000 in 1 YEAR
- GE CEO Jeff Immelt is paid \$32,000 in 1 AFTERNOON
