2013, GE workers' hospital admissions dropped 14%, outpatient radiology visits were down 11%, ER visits declined 12%, and specialist visits were 4% lower. To add to our misery, GE dumped the responsibility for getting the bills paid onto us and we often spend our hours a week trying to get our claims paid. **It's supposed to be our *healthcare*, not GE's *wealthcare*.** Come to tomorrow's meeting and talk about it.
