

# TURN OUT THE VOTE UE TO TURN THE TIDE

For the last two years our federal government, and far too many state governments, have been dominated by anti-worker politicians. The results have been disastrous for working people:

- **An anti-worker majority on the Supreme Court**, which has already issued decisions to weaken public-sector unions and make it harder to enforce labor laws.
- **A \$1.5 trillion tax scam** full of giveaways to the wealthy and corporations.
- **The militarization of immigration policy**, with mass incarceration of immigrants, including children, in detention centers reminiscent of concentration camps.
- **A new NAFTA that will not rebuild US manufacturing or raise wages**, but includes new corporate giveaways for banks, drug companies, tech companies and the energy industry.
- **Attacks on the collective bargaining rights of public-sector workers**, most notably in Iowa where the Republican majority virtually dismantled one of the better public-sector collective bargaining laws in the country.
- **Despite low unemployment, wages are not rising** — our communities still face a shortage of good jobs.

However, insurgents inspired by Bernie Sanders are increasingly challenging both right-wing Republicans and corporate Democrats. If working people — still the vast majority of potential voters — turn out to vote, we can put our country on the road towards winning:

- **“Medicare for All” single-payer healthcare**, taking healthcare off the bargaining table.
- **Recognition of the right of every worker to join a union.**
- **Investment in infrastructure** to create good jobs.
- **Free tuition** at public colleges and universities.
