


For the last two years our federal government, and far too many state governments, have been dominated by anti-worker politicians. The results have been disastrous for working people:

- An anti-worker majority on the Supreme Court, which has already issued decisions to weaken public-sector unions and make it harder to enforce labor laws.
- A \$1.5 trillion tax scam full of giveaways to the wealthy and corporations.
- The militarization of immigration policy, with mass incarceration of immigrants, including children, in detention centers reminiscent of concentration camps.
- A new NAFTA that will not rebuild US manufacturing or raise wages, but includes new
 corporate giveaways for banks, drug companies, tech companies and the energy industry.
- Attacks on the collective bargaining rights of public-sector workers, most notably
 in lowa where the Republican majority virtually dismantled one of the better public-sector
 collective bargaining laws in the country.
- Despite low unemployment, wages are not rising our communities still face a shortage of good jobs.

However, insurgents inspired by Bernie Sanders are increasingly challenging both right-wing Republicans and corporate Democrats. If working people — still the vast majority of potential voters — turn out to vote, we can put our country on the road towards winning:

- "Medicare for All" single-payer healthcare, taking healthcare off the bargaining table.
- Recognition of the right of every worker to join a union.
- Investment in infrastructure to create good jobs.
- Free tuition at public colleges and universities.
