On Friday, after a majority of Pride Industries employees vote UE, we will begin preparing for contract negotiations. We have a lot to do. We will:

- Elect a negotiating committee to represent all workers
- Draft and distribute a survey so employees can tell the Union what their priorities will be in contract negotiations
- Draft and ratify the proposals—the members will review the

proposals and vote on what proposals will be given to management

- Begin negotiations for a fair contract for all employees
- Elect stewards in all departments
