





“Dear UPSEU Representative,

We, the members of the City of Groton Police Department, UE #222, are signing this petition in response to the recent event that has triggered a Labor Board election for a possible union change. We were misinformed about the signing of the cards that were handed out to members and do not wish to change unions at this time, nor participate in any election. We respectfully request that you withdraw the petition filed by UPSEU with the Labor Board, in connection with Groton City Police Department, UE Local 222. Below are the signatures of the members who will vote “No”, if the petition from UPSEU is not withdrawn.”

The Petition to UPSEU from the City of Groton Police department is signed by 24 out of 25 members. The 25th member is out on medical leave and has stated he would vote UE as well.



“I have heard that UPSEU is claiming

that the New Fairfield Secretaries did better in these last contract negotiations than our UE Custodians. Nothing could be further from the truth. UPSEU was the very first group in this last round of bargaining in New Fairfield to break ranks and cave-in and agree to high up-front deductible health insurance plans and HSAs for their Secretaries. UPSEU actually increased their premium cost-sharing for their members to 14%, while UE decreased our percentage down to 11%. The UPSEU-represented Secretaries settled for 2.75% wage increases in each year of the contract, while in the same round of negotiations our UE members won 3.00% - 3.50% in general wage increases, and a step compression that earned us 18% - 26% wage increases in our new contract. If anyone is telling you that UPSEU did better than UE, they are not telling you the truth. Feel free to call me anytime at (203) 947-0205 if you would like to know more.”
